FFN's 4 Pillars Define the Post-Fracture Care FFN Multidisciplinary Clinical Pathway



Multidisciplinary care of the acute fracture episode, addressing frailty as well as the fracture itself

Formation of multidisciplinary national alliances to promote education and policy change that enable the clinical pillars



Excellent rehabilitation to recover function, independence and quality of life, starting immediately but continued long term

Reliable secondary prevention after every fragility fracture, addressing falls risk as well as bone health
